## **BUSINESS POST CARDS**

A postcard or post card is a piece of thick paper or thin <u>cardboard</u>, typically rectangular, intended for writing and mailing without an <u>envelope</u>. Non-rectangular shapes may also be used but are rare. There are novelty exceptions, such as <u>wooden postcards</u>, copper postcards sold in the <u>Copper Country</u> of the U.S. state of <u>Michigan</u>, and <u>coconut</u> "postcards" from tropical islands

In some places, one can send a postcard for a lower fee than a <u>letter</u>. <u>Stamp</u> <u>collectors</u> distinguish between postcards (which require a <u>postage stamp</u>) and <u>postal</u> <u>cards</u> (which have the postage pre-printed on them). While a postcard is usually printed and sold by a private company, individual or organization, a postal card is issued by the relevant <u>postal authority</u> (often with pre-printed postage)
